Guidelines for Submitting Photos

Professional headshots are an important way for us to help advertise events and speakers to our network. If you don't already have a professional headshot for us to use, we've put together some guidelines for taking your own.

- Aspect ratio = 1:1 (square). Not vertical.
- No photo manipulation (filters, etc.)
- High resolution (300 dpi) preferred but no less than 150 dpi
- Professional head shot or candid is acceptable. Photo subject should be facing the camera straight on.
- Photo should include chest, shoulders and head with a sufficient margin around the subject (not tightly cropped).
- Photo should be color and well lit. Avoid a busy background.
- Position your camera so that the lighting is behind the camera and pointing towards you.
- If your camera has a special "portrait mode," use that setting as it is optimized for taking photos of people as the subjects.
- File format should be .jpg or .png


